This Bid Bulletin is issued to supplement, modify or amend certain items in the bidding documents to conform to some provisions of GPPB Resolution No. 03-2012 as adopted by PMO – Limay Resolution No. 007 dated October 29, 2013. The Bidders shall take note of the following items carefully and consider them in the preparation of their bid proposals, as these will form part of the contract documents:

- Insertions/Modifications on the Instruction To Bidders:
 1. Instruction to Bidders Section 18 shall include GPPB Resolution No. 03-2012 – Resolution Approving and Adopting Bid Securing Declaration as an Additional Form of Bid Security, as follows:

ITB Clause 18.1.e.: In lieu of bid security mentioned in Section 27.2 of the IRR of RA 9184, the bidder may submit a Bid Securing Declaration that is an undertaking which states, among others, that the bidder shall enter into contract with the procuring entity and furnish the required performance security within ten (10) calendar days, or less, as indicated in the Bidding Documents, from receipt of the Notice of Award, and committing to pay the corresponding fine and be suspended for a period of time from being qualified to participate in any government procurement activity in the event it violates any of the conditions stated therein as required in the guidelines issued by the GPPB. **Bid Securing Declaration as an Additional Form of Bid Security, attached hereto as Annex “D”.**

2. Instruction To Bidders (ITB) Section 18.3 shall be modified as follows:

ITB Clause 18.3. No bid security or Bid Securing Declaration shall be returned to bidders after the opening of bids and before contract signing, except to those that failed or declared as post dis-qualified, upon submission of a written waiver of their right to file a motion for reconsideration and/or protest. Without prejudice on its forfeiture, bid securities shall be returned only after the bidder with the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid has signed the contract and furnished the performance security, but in no case later than the expiration of the bid security validity period indicated in the ITB Clause 18.2.

- Insertions/modifications on the BID Data Sheet (BDS)

3. BDS Clause 18 shall include:

18.1.4 In lieu of bid security mentioned in Section 27.2, the Bidder may submit Bid Securing Declaration that is an undertaking which states, among others, that the bidder shall enter into contract with the procuring entity and furnish the required performance security within ten (10) calendar days, or less, as indicated in the Bidding Documents, from receipt of the Notice of Award, and committing to pay the corresponding fine and be suspended for a period of time from being qualified to participate in any government procurement activity in the event it violates any of the conditions stated therein as required in the guidelines issued by the GPPB.

All other terms and conditions specified in the Bid Documents for the REPAIR/REPLACEMENT OF DAMAGED/MISSING RUBBER DOCK AND TRUCK TIRE FENDERS AT VARIOUS PORTS OF PMO – LIMAY shall remain the same.
