SUBJECT :

Reduction of Stevedoring, Arrastre and Stripping/ Stuffing Rates for Domestic Containers Measuring Five (5) Feet and Below

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 20 of Presidential Decree No. 857, as amended, and in line with the need to further rationalize the tariff for the handling of domestic containers, the stevedoring, arrastre and stripping/stuffing charges for five (5) footer and below containers shall be as follows:

1. Stevedoring

The rate shall be 85% of the applicable break-bulk rates.

2. Arrastre and Stripping/Stuffing

- a. FCL Containers the arrastre charge shall be 85% of the restructured uniform rates for 10 footer and below containers or 85% of the prevailing rates for 10 footer containers for cargo handling operators whose cargo handling tariff schedules have not yet been restructured.
- b. Containers that are stripped/stuffed (LCL) at the pier/wharf/terminal inside the port area the arrastre charges shall be 85% of the existing rates on contents, chargeable against the owners/consignees of the goods.
- c. In addition, stripping/stuffing charges shall be 1/3 of the 85% of the commodity rates to be charged against shipping companies.

All previous arrangements on existing rates for the handling of containers/containerized cargo inconsistent with this Order are hereby repealed or amended accordingly.

This Order shall take effect fifteen (15) days after publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
