PPA MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 22 - 79

SUBJECT: Revised Guidelines on the

Processing of Applications for Arrastre/Stevedoring

Permits

T O : ALL CONCERNED

To institute a more effective system of evaluating applications for permits to render arrastre, stevedoring or other related port services, hereunder prescribed is the revised procedure designed to carry out that objective, to wit:

- 1. All applications for arrastre/stevedoring permit shall be filed directly with the Port Management Unit concerned.
- 2. The Port Manager should evaluate the application and issue a certification attesting to the fact that:
  - a) An applicant has satisfactorily complied with Memorandum Order No. 21 and all other pertinent rules and regulations;
  - b) An ocular inspection of the applicant's equipment and facilities was conducted and he finds the same sufficient for the service intended to be rendered;
  - c) A detailed list of relevant documents was submitted to Head Office and that the same were personally evaluated by him. Each and every page must be numbered consecutively and signed in full by the Port Manager concerned.
- 3. In addition to the foregoing certification requirement, the Port Manager must submit a definite recommendation on whether to grant or deny a particular application stating his reasons in support thereof (e.g., not: "For your consideration").

4. Head Office through Traffic Operations Division, Port Operations Division and Regulation and Documentation Division reviews and evaluates the application and its enclosures as transmitted and thereafter shall prepare a joint Memo addressed to the Assistant Executive Officer recommending the grant or denial of a permit to subject applicant.

To be attached to this Joint Memo shall be the following documents:

- a. Application (docket);
- b. Certification of Port Manager;
- c. Indorsement to Port Manager; and
- d. Permit itself
- 5. After the signature or approval thereon by the Assistant Executive Officer the Monitoring Staff shall be responsible for the transmittal of all the documents back to the Port Manager concerned with the POED and RLAD being duly furnished with a copy each of the:
  - a. Joint Memo;
  - b. Certification of Port Manager;
  - c. Indorsement to Port Manager
  - d. Signed permit by the Assistant Executive Officer.

All PPA orders, rules, and regulations, particularly PPA Memorandum Order No. 21-77 dated May 27, 1977, inconsistent herewith are repealed or amended accordingly.

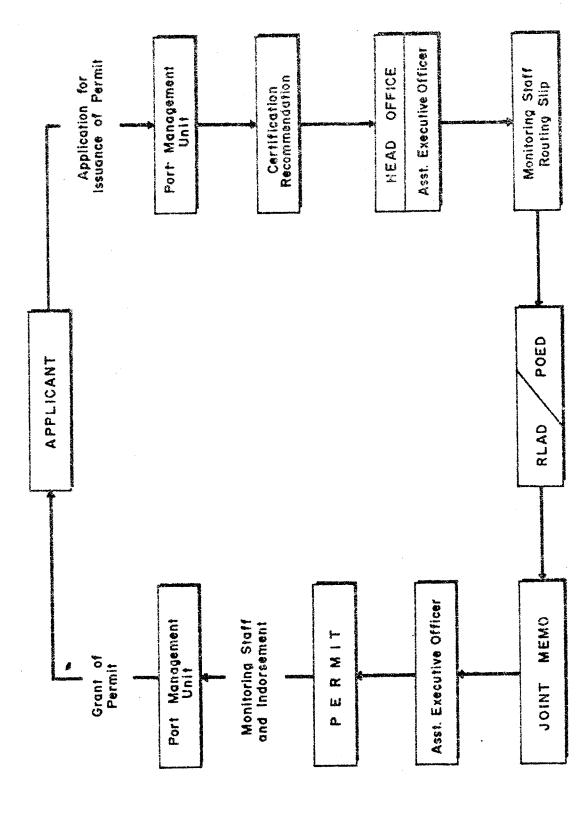
