

INVITATION TO BID

FOR THE:

REPAIR OF DAMAGED PORT FACILITIES DAMAGED BY TYPHOON OMPONG, PORT OF CLAVERIA, CAGAYAN

The Philippine Ports Authority, PMO-NORTHERN LUZON, through the Corporate Budget of the Authority for CY 2018, intends to apply the sum **P 10,260,532.00** being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payment under the contract for the **REPAIR OF DAMAGED PORT FACILITIES DAMAGED BY TYPHOON OMPONG, PORT OF CLAVERIA, CAGAYAN**. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.

The Philippine Ports Authority now invites bids for the following Scope of Works:

- 1) GENERAL EXPENSES
- 2) DEMOLITION
- 3) REPAIR WORKS @ CAUSEWAY PORTION

Completion of the Works is required in TWO HUNDRED FORTY (240) CALENDAR DAYS. Bidders should have completed, within three (3) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II, Instructions to Bidders.

Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary pass/fail criterion as specified in the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act 9184 (R. A. 9184), otherwise known as the “Government Procurement Reform Act.”

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships or organizations with at least seventy five percent (75%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines.

Interested bidders may obtain further information from the Bids and Awards Committee and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

A complete set of Bidding Documents may be purchased by interested Bidders from the address below and upon payment of a non-refundable fee for the Bidding Documents in the amount of **TWENTY EIGHT THOUSAND PESOS (P 28,000.00), VAT Inclusive.**

The Bids and Awards Committee will hold a Pre-Bid Conference on **September 30, 2019, 2:00 PM** at the Conference Room, PMO Northern Luzon, Poro, San Fernando City, La Union, which shall be open to all interested parties who have purchased the Bidding Documents.

Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before **2:00 PM of October 14, 2019.** All bids must be accompanied by a Bid Securing Declaration or any form of Bid Security in accordance with Section 27.2 of the Revised IRR of R.A. 9184 and latest income and business tax returns pursuant to the Implementing Rules of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184 in relation to Executive Order (EO) No. 398. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidder's representatives who choose to attend at the Conference Room, PMO Northern Luzon, Poro, San Fernando City, La Union on **October 14, 2019 at 3:00 PM.** Late bids shall not be accepted.

Required PCAB Registration: **MEDIUM A, CATEGORY B – “PORTS, HARBOR & OFFSHORE ENGINEERING”**
