INVITATION FOR NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT

BUSUANGA PORT DEVELOPMENT PROJECT, PORT OF BUSUANGA, **BUSUANGA, PALAWAN**

- 1. In view of the two (2) failed public biddings, the Bids and Awards Committee for Engineering Projects of the Philippine Ports Authority- Port Management Office of Palawan invites interested PhilGEPS registered contractors to participate in the negotiation for the BUSUANGA PORT DEVELOPMENT PROJECT, PORT OF BUSUANGA, BUSUANGA, PALAWAN with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of Nineteen Million Four Hundred Forty-Five Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety-One and 21/100 Pesos (P19,445,991.21) in accordance with Section 53.1 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act."
- 2. The BAC shall hold a negotiation conference on September 18, 2017; 3:00 P.M. at Social Hall, 3rd Floor, PPA Admin. Bldg., Port Area, Puerto Princesa City which shall be open to all interested prospective bidders.
- 3. The negotiated procurement is restricted to Filipino citizen/sole proprietorship, organization with at least seventy-five percent (75%) of interest or outstanding capital stocks belonging to citizens of the Philippines.
- 4. Bidders shall submit one (1) original and two (2) duplicate copies of the following documents in properly Book Bound, SEALED and MARKED envelope:
 - a. Certificate of PhilGEPS Registration (Platinum Membership)
 - b. PCAB License and Registration: at least Medium A- Ports, Harbor & Offshore Engineering
 - c. Statement of all ongoing government and private contracts
 - d. Statement of Single Largest Completed Contracts similar to the project
 - e. NFCC computation
 - f. Project Requirements
 - g. Omnibus Sworn Statement.
 - h. Other documents required under the Bid Documents.
- 5. Deadline for the submission of the eligibility documents, technical documents and financial proposal will be on October 2, 2017, 9:00 a.m. Opening of proposal will immediately follows at Social Hall, 3rd Floor, PPA Admin. Bldg., Port Area, Puerto Princesa City
