The Applicant shall submit at least three (3) copies of the following documentary requirements:

- 1. Application Letter together with a duly Sworn Information/Personal Data Sheet
- 2. School Credentials (Diploma/Transcript of Records);
- 3. Certificate as Master Mariner
- 4. Copies of Certificates of Training Courses attended;
- 5. Copy of the Pilot Examination Rating, License/Certificate issued by MARINA or PCG to practice as Harbor Pilot in the pilotage district applied for;
- 6. Employer's certification of Services Rendered as Ship Master (names of vessels, tonnages, ports of call and length of service thereon including frequency of calls on the waters applied for)
- 7. Current Board of Marine (BMI) Clearance to the effect that no case has been filed, pending and/or decided against the applicant
- 8. If already a <u>Harbor Pilot</u>, a Certification from the Chief Pilot stating the length of service and pilotage districts/waters served, including vessels/tonnages handled as harbor pilot
- 9. Current Physical and Mental Fitness Certificate from Government Physician
- Outstanding Accomplishments (Plaques/Awards/Commendations relative to maritime profession/Port Service);
- 11. Other relevant information/documents that would support his application as harbor pilot.

Only those applications with complete documentary requirements received on or before the deadline which is set on **November 30**, **2023** shall be processed.
