**RESOLUTION NO. 16-2018**

**RESOLUTION DECLARING FAILURE OF BIDDING (2<sup>nd</sup> Failure)**

**WHEREAS**, the Bids and Awards Committee for PMO-NCR North (BAC-NCR-N) advertised the Invitation to Bid for the Project: Various Repair Works at Radar Station 2, Corregidor Island, Cavite (**Re-bidding**) at PHILGEPS and PPA Websites, and at conspicuous places at PPA Offices in Manila continuously for the period November 8-26, 2018;

**WHEREAS**, in response to the said advertisement, only one (1) prospective bidder secured the corresponding Bid Documents, namely: Jay-Del Construction;

**WHEREAS**, the lone bidder submitted its bid before the set deadline at 12:56 PM of November 26, 2018;

**WHEREAS**, the first envelope containing the technical documents was opened and was declared "PASSED" on the condition that the BAC-TWG will further evaluate the submitted documents by the bidder;

**WHEREAS**, the second envelope containing the financial documents was opened and declared "PASSED" by the BAC;

**WHEREAS**, the BAC instructed the BAC-TWG to subject the submitted bid proposal of Jay-Del Construction for further evaluation;

**WHEREAS**, the BAC-TWG submitted to the BAC its evaluation report on November 27, 2018, with the following results:

1. On the Technical documents, the following comments/observation was noticed:
  - 1.1 Arithmetical error in the amount of Php1,000,000.00 was determined in the Net Financial Contracting Capacity (NFCC).
  - 1.2 The submitted Contractor's License (PCAB) was already expired Last June 30, 2018.
2. On the Financial Documents, no evaluation was made by the BAC-TWG due to the result on the evaluation/findings made on the Technical Documents.

**WHEREAS**, the BAC approved and adopted the evaluations made by the BAC-TWG on the submitted bid documents of Jay-Del Construction;

**WHEREAS**, on a motion duly moved and seconded, the BAC declared the submitted bid proposal of Jay-Del Construction as "**FAILED**";
