WHEREAS, the Philippine Ports Authority - PMO Marinduque/Quezon advertised/posted the Request for Quotation for the Provision of Housing Facility of One (1) Unit Genset, Port of Sta. Cruz, Marinduque in the PhilGEPS and PPA websites and at the bulletin board of PMO-Marinduque/Quezon from November 22 to 28, 2017;

WHEREAS, three (3) contractors were sent letters (Request for Quotation) requesting them to submit price quotation for the subject project, namely:

WHEREAS, the deadline of submission and receipt of price quotation is December 5, 2017 at 9:00 A.M.;

WHEREAS, the three (3) above-named contractors submitted their price quotations, in sealed envelope, before the published deadline;

WHEREAS, at 9:30 A.M. on December 5, 2017, the price quotation of the above-mentioned contractors were opened and passed the requirements upon examination, and the results are tabulated as follows:



WHEREAS, the price quotation submitted by *Jeff Enterprises* has been found to be the lowest price quotation;


