AT ROAD APPROACH, PORT OF IPIL, TMO-ZAMBOANGA SIBUGAY**

***BAC Resolution Declaring Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid (LCRD)
and Recommending Approval***

BAC RESOLUTION NO. ZAM-PGEPCS-02-2018 (EP)

WHEREAS, the Philippine Ports Authority, PMO-Zamboanga, through its Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) and in accordance with the Revised IRR of RA 9184 posted and advertised the Invitation to Bid and Bidding Documents for the Repair of Grouted Riprap including Repair of Potholes and Fence at Road Approach, Port of Ipil, TMO-Zamboanga Sibugay on June 07, 2018 up to the opening of bids on July 02, 2018 in the PPA Website, Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS), Philippine Star Newspaper on June 07, 2018, and PMO Bulletin Board;

WHEREAS, in response to the said advertisements, there were (4) four Prospective Bidders who signified their intention to apply for the public bidding of the above-mentioned project and purchased the bidding documents, namely: 1. **JC Dela Vega Construction Supply**, 2. **Teddie Construction and Development Inc.**, 3. **Stoneline Construction**, and 4. **ZET Construction**;

WHEREAS, the BAC conducted a **Pre-Bid Conference** on **June 18, 2018** discussing among others the eligibility, technical and financial requirements of the project to be bid pursuant to Section 22 of the RA 9184;

WHEREAS, in the **receipt and opening of bids**, the (4) four prospective bidders submitted their bid envelopes before the deadline, which was opened on **July 02, 2018, 9:30 AM**;

WHEREAS, the BAC opened first the **Technical Envelope** of **JC Dela Vega Construction Supply** and checked each item of the technical documents against a checklist using a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion, the BAC found the technical documents specifically Item 11 as "Non-compliant" per requirements prescribed in **ITB Clause 12. Documents Comprising the Bid: Eligibility and Technical Components** and rated as "FAILED";

WHEREAS, the representative of **JC Dela Vega Construction Supply**, **Ms. Wilma P. Flores** opted not to file a motion for reconsideration, hence the second envelope was returned to her unopened;

WHEREAS, the BAC opened the **Technical Envelope** of the next bidder, **Teddie Construction and Development Inc.** and checked each item of the technical

documents against a checklist using a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion, the BAC found the technical documents compliant per requirements prescribed in **ITB Clause 12. Documents Comprising the Bid: Eligibility and Technical Components** and rated as "PASSED";

WHEREAS, the BAC proceeded to open the Second Envelope of **Teddie Construction and Development Inc.** and checked its financial documents against the requirements prescribed in **ITB Clause 13. Documents Comprising the Bid: Financial Component**, the Chairperson announced that the submitted financial documents found compliant and the bid amount **as read: Php20, 215,741.02** was below the **ABC: Php20, 226,124.00**. The BAC rated the financial bid as "PASSED";

WHEREAS, the BAC opened the submitted envelope of the next bidder, **Stoneline Construction**. It was found that the letter of **Stoneline Construction** was a non-participation in the bidding due to their estimated cost exceeded the required ABC;

WHEREAS, the BAC opened the **Technical Envelope** of the last bidder, **ZET Construction** and checked each item of the technical documents against a checklist using a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion, the BAC found the technical documents compliant per requirements prescribed in **ITB Clause 12. Documents Comprising the Bid: Eligibility and Technical Components** and rated as "PASSED";

WHEREAS, the BAC proceeded to open the Second Envelope of **ZET Construction** and checked its financial documents against the requirements prescribed in **ITB Clause 13. Documents Comprising the Bid: Financial Component**, the Chairperson announced that the submitted financial documents found compliant and the bid amount **as read: Php20, 136,122.05** was below the **ABC: Php20, 226,124.00**. The BAC rated the financial bid as "PASSED";

WHEREAS, the BAC conducted the detailed evaluation of Bid, after the two bidder passed the opening and checking of its Bids technical and financial pursuant to **ITB Clause 24. Opening and Preliminary Examination of Bids**, to determine the Single Calculated Bid;

WHEREAS, in the Bid Evaluation, the BAC determined the calculated bid price of **Teddie Construction and Development Inc.** as **Php20, 215,741.02** and **ZET Construction** as **Php20, 136,122.05**;

WHEREAS, after the bid has been received, opened, examined, and evaluated, the BAC passed a motion to declare the **BID OF ZET CONSTRUCTION AS THE LOWEST CALCULATED BID**;

WHEREAS, upon post-qualification conducted on July 04-05, 2018 on the submitted eligibility, technical and financial documents of **ZET Construction**, the result of Post-Qualification is **RESPONSIVE**;

NOW THEREFORE, We, the Members of the PMO-Zamboanga Bids and Awards Committee, hereby **RESOLVE** as it is hereby **RESOLVED**:



- a) To declare the bid of ZET Construction as the **LOWEST CALCULATED AND RESPONSIVE BID** for the Repair of Grouted Riprap including Repair of Potholes and Fence at Road Approach, Port of Ipil, TMO-Zamboanga Sibugay.
- b) To recommend for approval by the Port Manager of the PPA, PMO-Zamboanga, Zamboanga City the foregoing findings.
