*BAC Resolution Declaring Single Calculated and Responsive Bid (SCRB)  
and Recommending Approval*

BAC RESOLUTION NO. ZAM-PGEPCS-05-2018(EP4) / NRP-ZBO-05-18

WHEREAS, the Philippine Ports Authority, PMO-Zamboanga, through its Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) and in accordance with the Revised IRR of RA 9184 posted and advertised the Invitation to Bid and Bidding Documents for the Repair of Port Lighting System Harnessing Solar Power Energy, Port of Margosatubig, Zamboanga Del Sur on October 15, 2018 up to the submission of bids on November 05, 2018 in the PPA Website, Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS), and the PMO Bulletin Board;

WHEREAS, in response to the said advertisements, one (1) prospective bidder, **ALRAF Construction and Enterprises** signified its intention to bid and purchased the bidding documents;

WHEREAS, the BAC conducted a Pre-Bid Conference on October 23, 2018 discussing among others the eligibility, technical and financial requirements of the project to be bid pursuant to Section 22 of the RA 9184;

WHEREAS, upon the receipt and opening of bids, **ALRAF Construction and Enterprises** submitted its bid envelope before the deadline, and received by the BAC Secretariat;

WHEREAS, the BAC proceeded to open the Bid Envelope of **ALRAF Construction and Enterprises** by opening first the Technical Envelope and checked each item of the technical documents against a checklist using a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion. The BAC found the technical documents being compliant of the requirements prescribed in **ITB Clause 12. Documents Comprising the Bid: Eligibility and Technical Components** and rated as "PASSED";

WHEREAS, the BAC proceeded to open the Second Envelope of **ALRAF Construction and Enterprises** and the items in the financial bid components were checked against the requirements prescribed in **ITB Clause 13. Documents Comprising the Bid: Financial Component** and found as compliant and rated as "PASSED". The Chairperson announced the **Bid Price (As Read)** in the amount of **Php7,483,477.86** lesser than the ABC of Php7,721,910.00;

WHEREAS, the BAC conducted the detailed evaluation of Bids on **November 06, 2018** after **ALRAF Construction and Enterprises** passed the technical and financial bids pursuant to **ITB Clause 24. Opening and Preliminary Examination of Bids**, to determine the Single Calculated Bid;

WHEREAS, in the Bid Evaluation on **November 6, 2018**, the BAC determined the **Bid Price (As Calculated)** of **ALRAF Construction and Enterprises** in the amount of **Php7,483,477.86**;

WHEREAS, the BAC prepared the Abstract of Bids showing that **ALRAF Construction and Enterprises** as the **Single Calculated Bid**;

WHEREAS, upon Post-Qualification conducted on November 8, 9 & 12, 2018 on the submitted eligibility, technical and financial documents of **ALRAF CONSTRUCTION AND ENTERPRISES**, the result of Post-Qualification was **RESPONSIVE**;

NOW THEREFORE, We, the Members of the PMO-Zamboanga Bids and Awards Committee, hereby RESOLVE as it is hereby RESOLVED:

- a) To endorse the bid of **ALRAF CONSTRUCTION** as the **SINGLE CALCULATED AND RESPONSIVE BID** for the **REPAIR OF PORT LIGHTING SYSTEM HARNESSING SOLAR POWER ENERGY, PORT OF MARGOSATUBIG, ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR** in the Amount of **Php7,483,477.86**.
- b) To recommend for approval by the Port Manager of the PPA, PMO-Zamboanga, Zamboanga City the foregoing findings.
