4. BIR Certificate of Registration
5. Latest Income and Business Tax Returns
6. Certificate of PhilGEPS Registration
7. DTI/SEC Certificate of Registration

Bidders must submit their Quotation on the date & time specified in the above schedule. Late bids will not be accepted. Bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the forms in the amount equivalent to two percent (2%) or Surety Bond equivalent to five percent (5%) of the approved budget for the contract (ABC). Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.

The Authority reserves the right to accept or reject any or all Price Quotation, waive any informality or defects in the proposals received and to accept such price quotation that is most advantageous to the Philippine Ports Authority.
