

REQUEST FOR QUOTATION

1. The Philippine Ports Authority, Port Management Office) - Zamboanga (PPA, PMO-Zamboanga), through its Bids and Awards Committee for the Procurement of Goods and Services (BAC-PG), re-invites interested suppliers to quote for the "One (1) Lot Supply and Delivery of Purified Drinking Water for CY 2017 through Negotiated Procurement in accordance with Section 53 of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act No. 9184.

Non-submission of any of the above documentary requirements shall be a ground for disqualification.

The Supplier(s) who had submitted already their eligibility documents may submit, in lieu of the above-stated documents, a "Certification" issued by the BAC-PG Chairperson, together with any lacking documentary requirement (sealed in an envelope) and the Accomplished Price Quotation Form - Annex "A" (sealed in a separate envelope).

3. All quotations shall be submitted by mail, courier or hand carried on or before 2:00 PM of April 4, 2017 to the Supply Unit, Second Floor, Administration Building, Philippine Ports Authority, PMO-Zamboanga, Zamboanga City addressed to:

4. Quotations submitted after the deadline shall **NOT** be accepted; Price quotation in excess of the ABC shall be automatically disqualified.
5. All quotations shall be valid for a period of thirty (30) calendar days from the deadline of submission of quotations and shall be inclusive of the applicable 12% Value Added Tax (VAT).
6. The items mentioned above are grouped in one (1) lot and that the evaluation and contract award shall be **based on a lot basis**. There should be complete entries of price quotations for the items enumerated that compose the whole lot. Bidders who submit documents with incomplete entries of price quotations for the said lot shall be disqualified.
7. The said procurement shall be awarded to the supplier determined to have submitted the complete documents and with the lowest calculated and responsive quotation.
8. Any interlineations, erasures or overwriting shall be valid only if they are signed or initialed by the supplier or his/her authorized representative.
9. Prospective bidder shall be a duly licensed Filipino Citizen/Sole Proprietorship, Partnership, Corporation, or Cooperative duly organized under the laws of the Philippines, with at least sixty (60%) of the interest/ownership belongs to Filipino Citizens.
10. PPA, PMO-Zamboanga reserves the right to reject any or all quotations at any time prior to award of the procurement without thereby incurring any liability to the affected proponents and to waive any minor defects therein, and to accept quotation as may be considered advantageous to the government.
